Whether students are starting kindergarten or heading off



Family DevotionsAt Home With God: Family Devotions for the School Year by Anne Broyles

With the beginning of a new school year, it is a good time to rekindle our walk
with God. We can begin again to study His Word; begin again to notice His
blessings and to recognize His lessons for us; and begin again to seek ways to reflect

Let us begin with Ecclesiastes 3:1-8. Light a candle to begin. Let one family member read the verses aloud, or even switch off, verse to verse to give everyone a chance.

In these verses, God tells us there is a time for everything. Perhaps devotional time is a new beginning for your family. What are some important beginnings in your family's history? (marriages, births, jobs, moves, activities, school, etc.) Share memories with one another. What are everyone's hopes and goals for the school year, for work, for activities, for understanding God's Word? Write down each person's hopes and goals, and keep them in a special place to review throughout the year.




