Sanctify us also, that we may faithfully receive this holy sacrament, and serve you in unity, faithfulness, and peace; and at the last day, bring us with all Your saints into the joy of Your eternal Kingdom. All this we ask through Your Son, Jesus Christ: By Him, and with Him, and in Him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is Yours, Almighty God, now and forever.


## Welcome home to First United Methodist Church!
